MACKICHAN HALL BOYS HOSTEL

There are limited seats reserved for BMS students which will be allotted on first come first serve basis. The student on payment of the college fees is eligible for the hostel.

The hostel form can be accessed through the login ID provided to the student on his portal. The hostel form has all the information and instructions that a candidate should know. Nonetheless following are the answers for a few frequently asked questions.

Q1. What type of room will be allotted to the student?

First year students are always allotted sharing room, mostly triple sharing rooms. The rooms are non AC and without attached toilet facilities. Every floor has ample washrooms with shower and geyser, toilets (Indian and western), separate urinals, wash basins with washing machine facility.

Q.2 Will I be allowed to see the room?

No, as a policy of the society that isn't allowed. This is because which room will be allotted is not known and also if room is allotted to students roommates may not be available in the room at that time. But rest assured the rooms are well maintained and comfortable.

Q.3 What essentials must the student bring along so as to come prepared?

Each student is provided with a cot, cupboard, table chair and stand for drying clothes. Coir Mattress and not the cotton ones are needed and can be provided at a discounted cost of Rs.2850/- with prior intimation. Money to be paid in cash to the vendor. The choice is yours.

Q.4 When can the student join the hostel?

Once the hostel fees are paid, the student will be allotted room, even a day prior to joining the program but from **Monday to Friday between 5 to 6 pm only in the hostel office** in mandatory presence of one parent and a local guardian. Hard copy of hostel form along with copy of all uploaded supporting documents as mentioned with the form are needed.

Q.5 Does the hostel fee include both boarding and lodging facilities?

The hostel fees are only for lodging. Mess is compulsory. Mess charges of Rs.5800/-month are charged separately for both veg and nonveg (alternate days for dinner) meals. Meals include breakfast, lunch, evening tea with snacks and dinner.

Zero tolerance for ragging. Hostel office provides a separate hostel anti-ragging undertaking.

Residence of the Warden is in the hostel.

Hostel In time is 8.30 pm Monday to Friday & 10.30 pm on weekends.

Other details during the meeting in person with one parent and local guardian on the evening of room allotment.
